Membership Meeting Minutes – September 19, 2018

The meeting was held at the Porsche of Wichita dealership at 13th and Greenwich. Thanks to Walser and Porsche of Wichita for hosting and to the catering crew for their hard work and excellent meal. There were 28 members in attendance.

Membership Update, Barry Anderson – Barry reported that we lost 3 members this month. We currently have a total of 169 primary members and 244 total members. Two new members attended the meeting.

Charity Report, Jeff Reisman – Jeff Reisman reported that our charity fund balance is \$2149. The bucket was passed for additional donations to the fund. Last year we had approximately \$3,600 in total to distribute. At the November meeting we will pick charities to support with the funds raised this year. We will also discuss taking some of the funds in the general funds and allocating them to the Charity Fund. Jeff also reminded members that they should start gathering items to donate for the charity auction at the After Holiday Party to be held in January.

Autocross Report, Tom Zickuhr – Tom reported that we had great weather for the last event reminded members that the next autocross event will be held at Road Yoder on Sunday, September 30. Registration for that event is open now.

Treasury Report, Carl Compton – Carl reported that the checking account balance, including the charity fund, is approximately \$12,700.

Social Activities, Dan McKenzie – Dan was out of town but various members reported on several upcoming events.

- On Saturday, October 13 the new member party for all club members will be held at the garage of Don Mayer at Exec U Store on Greenwich Road. There will be no charge for this event, all food and drinks will be provided by the club. This is one of our premier events for the year and everyone is encouraged to attend. - SCCA Street Survival driving course will be held at Road Yoder on October 6. It is for young drivers ages 15 to 21.
