PRESIDENT’S REPORT:

President Jeff Reisman announced the club slate of officers for 2020: President Jeff Reisman; Vice President: Dan McKenzie; Treasurer: Luke Lear; Secretary: Jan Arbuckle. No other names were submitted by the members in attendance. The slate was elected unanimously.

SOCIAL REPORT:

Dan McKenzie announced that the club will continue the monthly social gathering at The Prost at Revolutsia on East Central on first Tuesdays at 6 p.m. The Club After-Holiday charity fund raising event is scheduled on Saturday January 18, 2020, starting at 6:30 pm at Rolling Hills Country Club. A motion from the floor was proposed and approved to transfer undesignated club funds into our charity fund to bring the available balance to \$3000 and then issue 3 charity awards of \$1000 each. Eight charities were proposed for club consideration: Alzheimer Association, Wichita Children's Home, Kansas Humane Society, Lifeline Animal Placement and Protection, Fundamental Learning Center, Kansas Honor Flight, CASA of Sedgwick County and the ICT Street Team. Members voted on paper ballots and the following charities were selected: Lifeline Animal Placement & Protection, CASA, and ICT Street Team. Checks will be presented to the winning charities at The Prost during the social hour on January 7 at 6:00 pm. Pictures will be posted on our Porsche

Club website, Prost Facebook Page and President Jeff will contact Splurge Magazine to publicize our club's charitable efforts.
